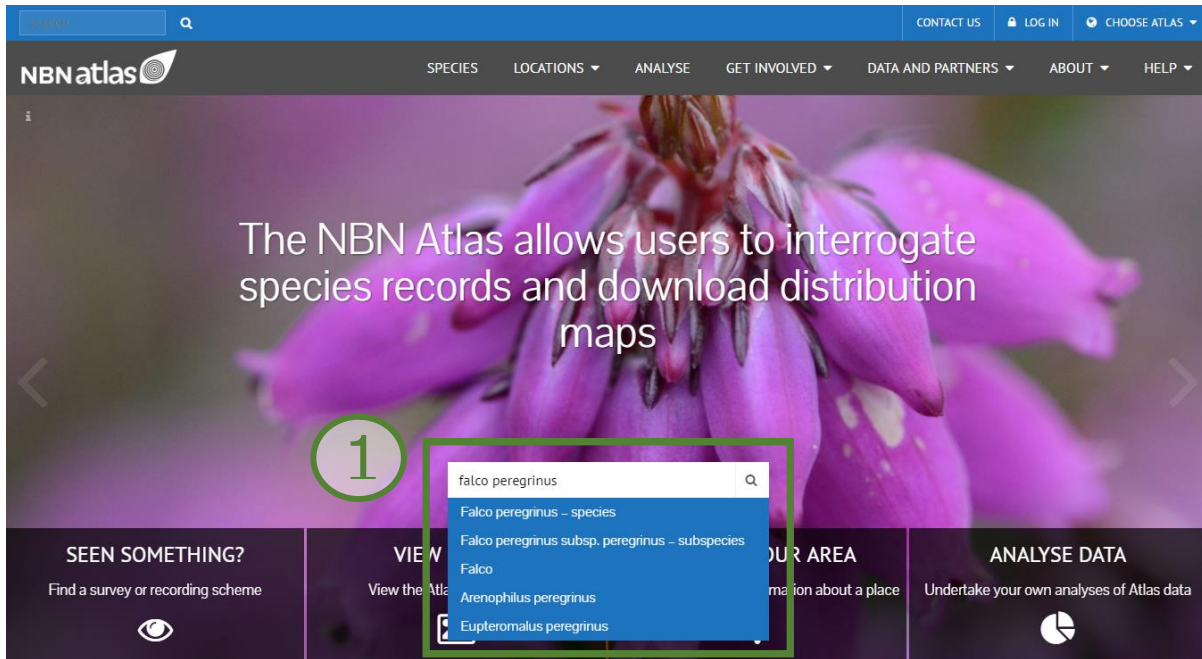


NBN Atlas: Finding Basic Species Information

-Every species recorded in the Atlas has an associated overview page, providing basic information on the species. To access information for a species, search for the species from the NBN Atlas home page (1).



-Select the species from the search results page (2). Your species should appear near the top, but if you need to refine or sort your search results you can do so. If there are multiple recorded names for the same species, records will be held under the currently accepted name, and you will be directed to the appropriate page.

Search for **falco peregrinus** returned 67 results.

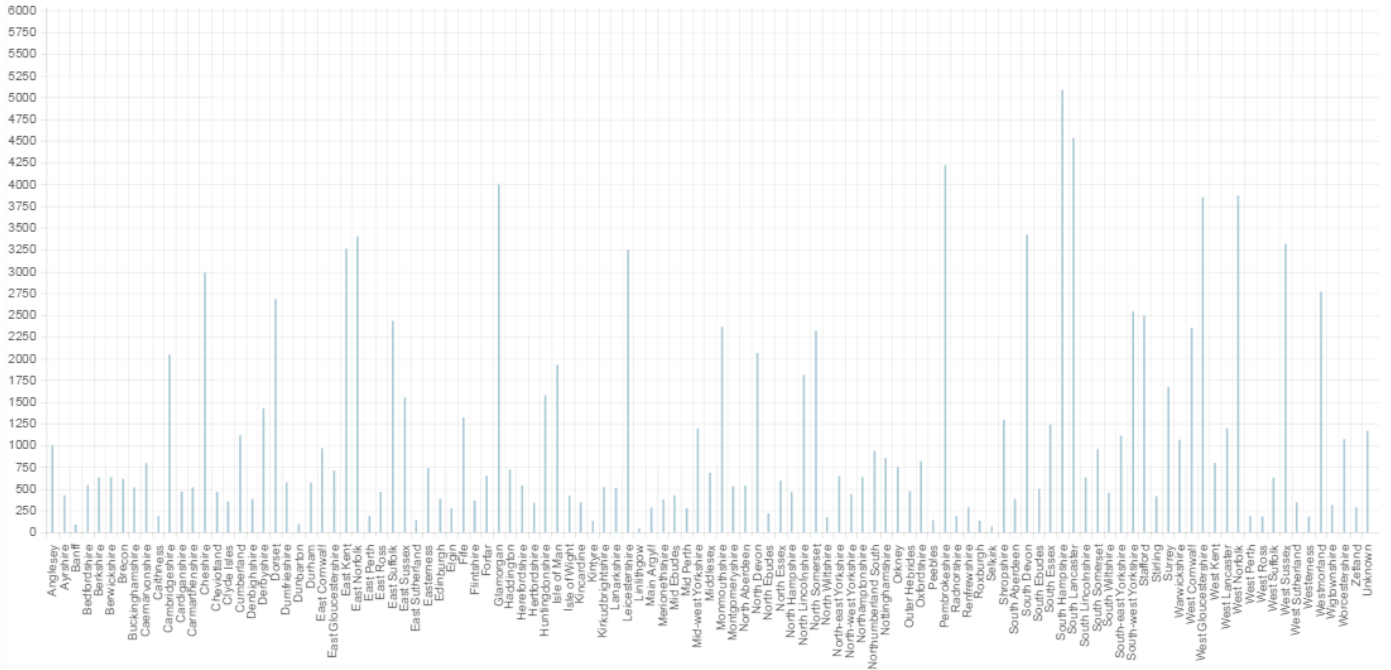

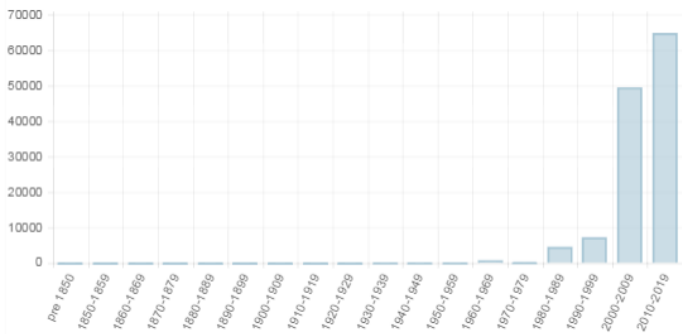
CHARTS SHOWING BREAKDOWN OF OCCURRENCE RECORDS (126,966 RECORDS)

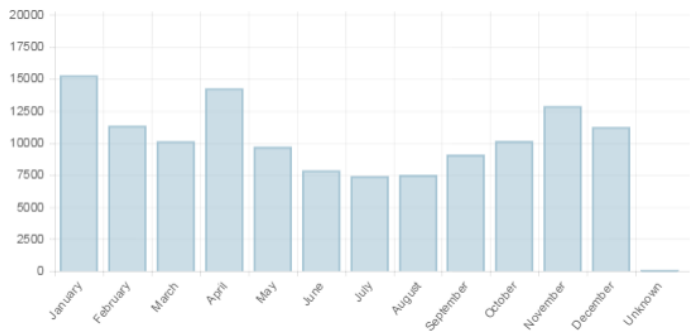
By Watsonian Vice County



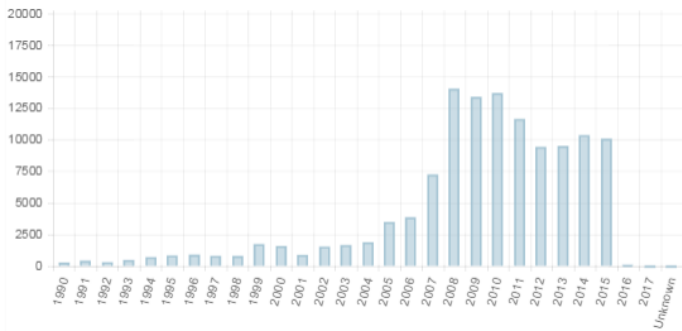
By decade




By month




