

NBN Atlas: Viewing Species Information on a Map

- -from the **NBN Atlas** home screen, search for your species of interest using the search bar **(1)**.
- -select the species from the search results page
- -scroll down to the distribution map and click 'View map' (2).
- -you will be redirected to an interactive map on the **Occurrence Records** page.




-the display can be altered at the top of the map (3). The records can be displayed as grid squares of different sizes, or as points, which can be coloured according to different criteria. The size, opacity and outline of displayed records can also be altered

-to zoom in or out, use the '+' and '-' symbols in the top left of the map (4). To move around the map, simply click and drag.




Occurrence records map (165,082 records)









-to limit the displayed records to a specific drawn area, use the drawing tools, found below the zoom buttons. You can draw a circle, rectangle, or other polygon by selecting the appropriate tool and clicking on the map (5). These areas can be edited or deleted with the buttons below (6).





- -the appearance of the map can be altered by pressing the icon (7) on the left of the map.
- -to apply a filter to the displayed records, select one from the window on the left (8) (Note- the display will be reset each time a filter is applied).
- -to change the filters that are available, click 'Customise filters' in the top-left (9). Select the filters you would like to add and click 'Update' (10).
- -to learn more about the records at a point or area, simply click the appropriate point you are interested in **(11)**.
